



**Extra Help**  
 Low Income Subsidy Premiums for the  
 2018 Blue Medicare Advantage (HMO) and Blue Medicare Advantage (PPO)  
 Plan Year

Medicare provides Part D premium and cost-sharing assistance to beneficiaries who qualify for the program's low income subsidy, also called the LIS. An enrollee's premium will generally be lower once he/she receives "Extra Help" from Medicare, if the enrollee joins a Blue Medicare Advantage plan with monthly premium.

If you qualify for "Extra Help", you may pay \$0 or a reduced monthly premium. The premiums listed are for both medical services and prescription drug benefits (MA-PD plans only).

People with limited incomes may qualify for "Extra Help" to pay for their prescription drug costs. If a person qualifies, Medicare could pay for up to seventy-five (75) percent or more of his/her drug costs including monthly prescription drug premiums, annual deductibles, copays and/or co-insurance. Additionally, those who qualify will not be subject to the coverage

gap or a late enrollment penalty. Many people are eligible for these savings and don't even know it.
